

BLACKEMINIPSCHOP

'Smiths' work with metal – what colour iron do Blacksmiths work with? What colour does the metal change to when it is hot enough to bend? Which colour is the hottest part of the flame that they use to heat the metal to make it soft enough to bend?

INCULIN/ GENTRE

Find an animal/insect that uses its colour for: Camouflage Attraction Warning If you were an animal, what colour would you be and why?



SHOWRING

There are many examples of wood, stone and metal used to make the Cobb+Co Museum building. How many different colours can you find? What colour does metal change to when it rusts? What colour are the brick walls inside the Museum? What colour soil is common in Toowoomba?

Find the specimens of ochre. How many different ochre colours can you find? What is ochre used for? Look at the colours in the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander flags. What does each colour represent?
