Chapter 2 – Chronological annotated bibliography of scientific descriptions of Andrew Goldie specimens to 1901

Von Mueller, F. 1875–89. *Descriptive Notes on Papuan Plants*. (Government Printer: Melbourne).

Parts III (Jun 1876), IV (Dec 1876) and V (Feb 1877) included descriptions of over 100 species collected by Goldie during his first year in New Guinea, including type descriptions of *Combretum goldieanum* and *Bauhinia williamsii*.

Moore, T. 1877. *Adiantum neoguineense*. *The Gardeners' Chronicle*. 1877: 12.

Type description of a fern supplied to B.S. Williams by Goldie.

Ramsay, E.P. 1877. Notes on a collection of birds from Port Moresby; with descriptions of some new species. *Proceedings of the Linnean Society of New South Wales* 1: 1877, Pp. 386–395.

Descriptions of 87 species of birds and five mammals and reptiles collected by Goldie. Includes type descriptions of *Melidora goldiei*, *Eopsaltria brunnea* and *Donacola nigriceps*.

Reichenbach, H.G. 1878. New Garden Plants. *The Gardeners' Chronicle*, 25 May 1878: 652.

Type descriptions of *Dendrobium goldiei* and *Dendrobium williamsianum*.

Reichenbach, H.G. 1878. *Dendrobium goldiei*. *The Garden* 14, 14 September 1878: 244.

Short description and figure.

Ramsay, E.P. 1878. Descriptions of five species of new birds, from Torres Straits and New Guinea, &c. *Proceedings of the Linnean Society of New South Wales*: 72–5.

Includes type description of *Lorius gulielmi*, collected by Goldie.

Ramsay, E.P. 1878. Contributions to the zoology of New Guinea. Parts I & II. *Proceedings of the Linnean Society of New South Wales* 3: 241–305.

Description of 14 species of mammals and 204 birds collected by Goldie, Shaw, Blunden and Morton on Goldie's second expedition, with a few additional specimens from Broadbent. Includes 10 new species of bird.

Ramsay, E.P. 1879. Contributions to the zoology of New Guinea. Parts IV. & V. Remarks on recent collections, made by Mr. Andrew Goldie, in the south east portion of New Guinea and the Louisiades. *Proceedings of the Linnean Society of New South Wales* 4: 85–102.

Description of 4 species of mammals and 15 birds collected by Goldie.

Ramsay, E.P. 1880. Contributions to the zoology of New Guinea. Part VI. On some new and rare birds, from south east coast of New Guinea, &c. *Proceedings of the Linnean Society of New South Wales* 4, 1880: 464–470.

Description of 13 species of bird collected by Goldie and Lt. Richards. Includes type descriptions of three new species collected by Goldie.

Salvin, O. 1880. Species of Pigeon from New Guinea, *Ibis* 22 (3): 364–5.

Colour plate and description of *Otidiphaps regalis* collected by Goldie.

Godman, F.D. & Salvin, O. 1880. Descriptions of some supposed New Species of Butterflies from New Guinea. *Proceedings of the Zoological Society*: 609–14.

Type descriptions of ten new species, six of which are figured, including *Papilio goldiei*, described from three separate collections made by Goldie.

Salvadorio, T. 1880. Prodrromus Ornithologiae Papuasiae et Moluccarum. *Annali del Museo civico di storia naturale di Genova* 16: 62–82 & 183–99.

- Includes references to several specimens collected by Goldie.
- Sharpe, R.B. *et al.* 1881-1898, *Catalogue of the Birds in the British Museum* 5–10, 13, 14, 16, 17, 19–24, 26, 27.
- Includes descriptions of 262 specimens covering 120 species collected by Goldie, 11 of which are type specimens and 8 are figured.
- Gurney, J.H. 1882. On some Raptorial Birds recently acquired by the Norwich Museum. *Ibis* **24**, 1882: 452–457.
- Includes description of four specimens collected by Goldie.
- Ramsay, E.P. 1883. Contributions to the Zoology of New Guinea. Part VII', *Proceedings of the Linnean Society of New South Wales* **8**: 15–29.
- Description of 2 mammals, 10 birds and 18 eggs collected by 'Messrs Rolles and Hunstein and other members of Mr Goldie's party'. Includes 2 new species of mammal and 7 new birds.
- Macleay, W. Contribution to a Knowledge of the Fishes of New Guinea. *Proceedings of the Linnean Society of New South Wales* **7**: 224–50, 351–67, 585–98 & Vol.8: 252–80.
- Description of 405 species collected by Goldie, with 56 new species, including *Serranus goldiei*, *Mesoprion goldiei* and *Aristeus goldiei*.
- Salvadorio, T. 1883. Prodrömus Ornithologiae Papuasiae et Moluccarum', *Annali del Museo civico di storia naturale di Genova*. **18**: 6–9, 318–37 & 416–30.
- Includes references to numerous specimens collected by Goldie.
- Macleay, W. 1883. On a new and remarkable fish of the family Mugilidae from the interior of New Guinea. *Proceedings of the Linnean Society of New South Wales* **8**: 2–6.
- Description of *Aeschrichthys goldiei*.
- Gurney, J.H. 1883. On an Owl from South-east New Guinea, allied to *Ninox terricolor*, Ramsay, but apparently distinct and undescribed. *Ibis* **25**: 169–72.
- Type description of *Ninox goldii*, based on three specimens collected by Goldie recently acquired by the Norwich Museum.
- Salvin, O. & Godman, F.D. 1883. Description of a recently discovered Species of Paradisea. *Ibis* **25**: 199–202.
- Type description and figure of *Paradisea decora*.
- Druce, H.H. 1883. Descriptions of a new Genus and some new Species of Heterocera. *Proceedings of the Zoological Society* **16**: 777–83.
- Includes type descriptions of four specimens collected by Goldie, three of which are figured. Includes *Lyssidia goldiei* and *Bociraz goldiei*.
- Sharpe, R.B. 1883. Contributions to the Ornithology of New Guinea, Part VII, Diagnoses of new Species of Birds from the back of the Astrolabe Range. *The Journal of the Linnean Society (Zoology)* **16**: 317–19.
- Description of 11 new species, including *Trichoglossus goldiei*, collected by Goldie in South East New Guinea.
- Sharpe, R.B. 1883. Contributions to the Ornithology of New Guinea, Part VIII. *The Journal of the Linnean Society (Zoology)* **16**: 422–47.
- Description of 120 specimens from two large collections by Goldie, including one new species (*Aethomias guttata*) not previously described by Sharpe, and 35 specimens collected by Hunstein.
- Salvin, O. & Godman, F.D. 1884. On a third Species of Otidiphaps. *Proceedings of the Zoological Society* **17**: 33–4.
- Type description of *Otidiphaps insularis* collected by Goldie.
- Sharpe, R.B. 1884. Contributions to the Ornithology of New Guinea, Part IX, On further Collections made by Mr. A. Goldie in the Astrolabe Mountains. *The Journal of the Linnean Society (Zoology)* **17**: 405–408.
- Description of birds supplied to the British Museum by Salvin & Godman, forwarded to them by Goldie. 'A few of the birds have passed into the national collection, and three of these possess more than ordinary interest.' Includes *Erythrotriorchis Doriae*, *Ninox theomacha* (= *Ninox Goldiei*) and *Amblyornis subularis*.
- Sharpe, R.B. 1884. Notes on some species of Birds of the family Dicæidæ. *Proceedings of the Zoological Society* **17**: 578–80.

- Includes type description of *Dicaeum pulchrius* from a specimen in the British Museum collected by Goldie.
- Brazier, J. 1884. 'Synonymy of some land Mollusca from Papua or New Guinea', *Proceedings of the Linnean Society of New South Wales* 9: 804–806.
- Identification and classification of *Helix goldiei*.
- Miklouho-Maclay, N. de. 1885. On two new species of Dorcopsis from the south coast of New Guinea. *Proceedings of the Linnean Society of New South Wales* 10: 145–150.
- Description of two marsupial skins from the Macleay Museum collected by Goldie identified as new species: *Dorcopsis beccarii* and *Dorcopsis macleayi*.
- Miklouho-Maclay, N. de. 1885. On two new species of Macropus from the south coast of New Guinea *Proceedings of the Linnean Society of New South Wales* 9: 890–895.
- Type description of the kangaroo *Macropus jukesii* based on specimen collected by Goldie preserved in the Macleay Museum.
- Smith, E.A. 1887. Notes on some Land Snails from New Guinea and the Solomon Islands with Descriptions of New Species. *The Annals and Magazine of Natural History* 19: 416–426.
- Includes description of *Helicina solitaria* collected by Goldie and presented to the British Museum by John Brazier of Sydney.
- Gould, J. & Sharpe, R.B. 1875–88. *Birds of New Guinea and the Adjacent Papua Islands*. (Sutherland & Co.: London).
- Includes numerous figures from specimens collected by Goldie.
- Druce, H.H. & Bethune-Baker, G.T. 1893. A Monograph of the Butterflies of the Genus *Thysonotis*. *Proceedings of the Zoological Society*. 536–53.
- Includes figure of specimen of *Thysonotis epicoritus* collected by Goldie.
- Distant, W.L. 1893. On some allied Pentatomidæ, with Synonymical Notes. *Annals and Magazine of Natural History*. 389–94.
- Includes type description of the bug *Coctoteris exiguous*, collected by Goldie.
- Mead, G.S. 1894. Birds of New Guinea. *The American Naturalist* 28: 915–20; 1895 29: 1–9, 409–17, 627–36, 1056–65; 1896 30: 195–200, 285–90, 710–716; 1897 31: 204–10.
- Includes several references to Goldie specimens.
- Druce, H.H. 1894. Descriptions of some new Species of Agaristidæ. *Annals and Magazine of Natural History*. 21–4.
- Includes type description of the butterfly *Darantasia goldiei*, collected by Goldie.
- Grant, O.W.R. 1896. On a new Species of Honey-eater (*Ptilotis spilogaster*) from South-eastern New Guinea. *Ibis* 38(22): 250–2.
- Type description of two specimens of *Ptilotis spilogaster* in the British Museum collected by Goldie, previously misidentified as *Ptilotis filigera* in the BM catalogue.
- Druce, H.H. 1898. Descriptions of some new Species of Heterocera. *Annals and Magazine of Natural History*. 207–15.
- Includes type description of the butterfly *Agarista goldiei*, collected by Goldie.
- Druce, H.H. 1899. Descriptions of some new Species of Heterocera. *Annals and Magazine of Natural History*. 201–5.
- Includes type description of *Scoliacma brunnea*, collected by Goldie.
- Druce, H.H. 1899. Descriptions of some new Species of Heterocera from Tropical America, Africa, India and the Eastern Islands. *Annals and Magazine of Natural History*. 465–74.
- Includes type descriptions of the butterflies *Miresa binea* and *Miresa aquia*, collected by Goldie.
