


Eungella (pronounced young-ga-la), one hour west of Mackay, lies within the longest continuous stretch of rainforest in Australia outside the Wet Tropics of north Queensland.

Broken River in Eungella National Park is a popular place to see platypus in the wild. Platypus construct their burrows in the river bank but come out to swim and look for food at dawn and dusk. They are shy and secretive, so make sure you are very quiet to have the best chance of spotting them.
