


Eungella (pronounced young-ga-la), one hour west of Mackay, lies within the longest continuous stretch of rainforest in Australia outside the Wet Tropics of north Queensland.



Strangler Fig tree arch

Strangler fig trees have large tangled roots above the ground that grow around other trees and eventually 'strangle' them. This strangler fig tree arch is on the Cedar Grove walking track in Eungella National Park. It's so big you can walk through the middle of it!
