

How to connect to Eduroam in Mac OS X

Introduction

EduRoam is an agreement between a list of educational institutions to share access to their wireless networks. Being part of the EduRoam federation allows Queensland Museum Network Staff and students from other institutions who are visiting the Museums to connect to the EduRoam Wi-Fi network.

This guide will help show you how to connect to EduRoam network on a Mac OS X platform.


1. Select the Wi-Fi symbol in the system bar, and select Eduroam on the list. If it is not visible try selecting 'Other networks' and look for eduroam on the list.



2. Log in using your institution credentials (your email address) and select OK



3. It will try to verify Certificate, just Select Continue
